Field of Heroes

On Memorial Day weekend, the Westerville Sunrise Rotary club hosts the Field of Heroes across from the Westerville Community Center on Cleveland Avenue in Westerville, Ohio. The Field of Heroes displays 3,000 American flags creating an environment where visitors can walk among the flags, read dedications and reflect upon their personal heroes.

Flag Retirement Ceremony at First Responders Park

Each year American Flags are retired with the respect and dignity that they deserve on the anniversary of the official adoption of the American Flag by the Continental Congress in 1777. The ceremony is conducted by Westerville VFW Post 7993 and Westerville American Legion Post 171. Ripped and faded flags may be dropped off at the Westerville Community Center.

Veterans Day Celebration

Annually the City of Westerville hosts a free breakfast to honor community veterans. The patriotic program offers veterans an opportunity to partake in fellowship and reminisce together. Veterans are encouraged to share memorabilia collected during their military careers.

Honor Flight

Honor Flight recognizes and celebrates World War II and Korean War Veterans by flying them to Washington D.C. to visit memorials dedicated to their important service at no cost to them. Throughout the year a variety of fundraisers and activities are held which support the efforts of Honor Flight.

Ladies Swim Night

Periodically throughout the year ladies swim nights are offered. Ladies swim nights provide the perfect opportunity for women to take advantage of the indoor pool in a climate that may not be afforded during public open swims due to religious beliefs or modesty concerns.
