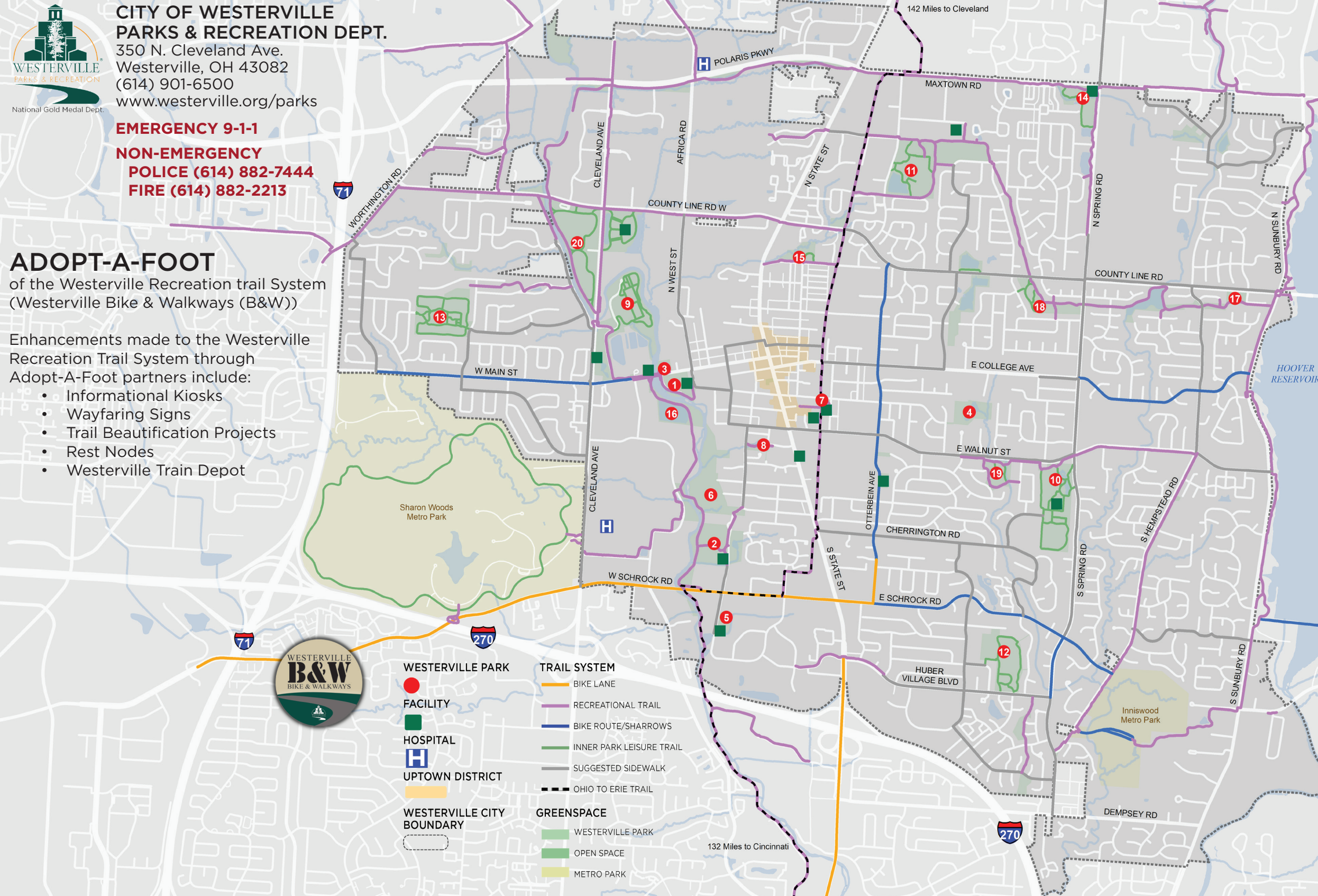

TRAILS

Alum Creek Trail From the dead end north of County Line Rd, south through Sports Complex then Heritage Park to Main St. East to Alum Creek, south across the Historical Bridge, under Schrock Rd to the Westerville Corporate limits	5.24 miles
Big Walnut Creek Trail County Line Rd at Sunbury Rd south through tunnel just north of Marlene, along Hoover Reservoir to Central College Rd	2.22 miles
County Line Trail From Ohio to Erie Trail west across Alum Creek to Worthington Rd	2.2 miles
Ohio to Erie Trail From Alum Creek Trail at Schrock Rd east to Charring Cross Drive behind Roush. North across State St to Polaris Trail at Maxtown Rd	3.93 miles
Polaris Trail N Spring Rd at Maxtown Rd west to Alum Creek Trail along Polaris Parkway	2.77 miles
Towers Trail From Big Walnut Creek Trail at Sunbury Rd, west to Towers Park, across County Line Rd, north to Hoff Woods Park, west to Ohio to Erie Trail	3.2 miles

TRAIL CONNECTORS

Alum Creek Park Trail Connector (I) At West St, connects Otterbein College through Alum Creek Park North across Main St bridge to the Alum Creek Trail	.3 miles
Alum Creek Park Trail Connector (II) At Cooper Rd, connects Alum Creek Park Trail to Sharon Woods Metro Park across Cleveland Ave.	.75 miles
Chipmunk Chatter Trail Connector North St at Central College Rd and Sunbury Rd west to gate at Inniswood Metro Gardens	.6 miles
Hoff Woods Connector Ohio to Erie Trail at Maplebrook Dr east to Hoff Woods Park	.15 miles
Westerville Library Connector At the Ohio to Erie Trail west to Library Rd	.09 miles
Africa Road Connector Polaris Parkway north to Corporate Limits	.11 miles

TRAIL RULES

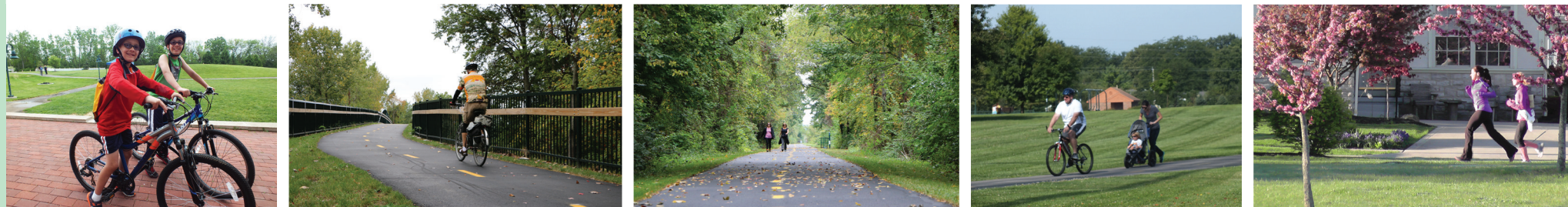
- Keep right and announce passing on left

- Caution at intersections
- Keep pets on leashes no longer than six feet
- Speed limit 15 MPH
- All rules under Ordinance No. 80-36 and 05-13

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BICYCLE SAFETY

Always wear a helmet. It's for your safety.

Keep your bike in good working order. Make sure lights and reflectors are installed.

STOP. LOOK. LISTEN. Never ride while distracted.

Speak up and let others know you are there. Saying "on your left" lets them know you are behind them and want to pass.

Use proper hand signals when you are turning.

Never assume a car, truck or other vehicle will stop or slow down for you while you are bicycling.

Obey all trail signs.
