Red is the most severe color, and will be based on **very** inappropriate actions or behaviors, clear intent to hurt/harm, and/or, continuous behavior issues while on Orange. If your child is on Red, he/she will be subject to suspension, based on the decision of the Camp Director. Blue will be given to a camper who displays outstanding behavior throughout the week. It is imperative that parents/guardians support this system at home, in order to ensure that your child does not continue to have behavioral issues throughout camps.
