What is the Community Care Program?

The Community Care Program is a daily telephone check-in service for homebound, handicapped, or elderly residents.

How much does the Community Care Program cost?

The Community Care Program is a **FREE SERVICE** to the residents of Westerville and Blendon Township. This service is provided through the cooperative efforts of the Westerville Police and Fire Divisions, Blendon Township Police and the Westerville Communications Division.

How does the Community Care Program work?

Once you are enrolled in the *Community Care Program*, a computer will call your home every day at a time determined by you. If everything is OK you only need to answer the phone and follow the message instructions. You do not need to say anything.



What if I don't answer the phone?

If you don't answer the phone the computer will automatically call the Westerville Communications Division as well as the person you designate as your emergency contact. At this time first responders will also be sent to your home to check on you and provide assistance if needed. (These responders can be canceled if we hear from you or your emergency contact that you are ok.)

What if I'm not going to be home?
