ORDINANCE NO. 09-46

TO AMEND SECTION 931.06, WATER SYSTEMS CAPACITY CHARGE, OF THE WESTERVILLE CODIFIED ORDINANCES

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTERVILLE, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 931.06, Water Systems Capacity Charge, of the Westerville Codified Ordinances, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"931.06 WATER SYSTEMS CAPACITY CHARGE.

- (a) <u>Definitions</u>. As used in this section:
- (1) "Service connection" means the connection of all or any part of a water service line to a tap.
- (2) "Tap" means the connection to a water main and the necessary pipes or lines extending from a water main to and including the curb stop or valve and box.
- (b) <u>Rates.</u> The following rates shall be charged for each water service connection made to any property and shall be paid at the time a permit is issued for the water connection. No person shall make a water service connection or any part thereof, unless a permit has been issued therefor by the Building Inspector. In the event that a tap is subsequently enlarged, the difference between the current charges for the two tap sizes shall be paid:

Diameter of Tap (in inches)	Rate For Connection
0.75	\$2,900
1.00	\$4,850
1.50	\$10,500
2.00	\$22,915
3.00	\$49,845
4.00	\$78,500
6.00	\$170,645
8.00	\$268,920
10.00	\$363,040
12.00	\$435,650
16.00	\$686,150

For any taps used to supply fire protection only, the rate shall be one-half the rate specified in this section.

(c) <u>Use of Money.</u> The funds received from the collection of such charges shall be deposited daily with the Director of Finance who shall credit them to the Water Revenue Fund from which Council may make appropriations for the payment of the cost and expense of the construction, management and repair of the water distribution system, water reservoir towers and

other water system improvements and extensions and for the payment of principal and interest on any debt incurred for the construction of such water distribution system, water reservoir towers and other water system improvements and extensions."

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after January 1, 2010.
